1. USU Center for HPE

Certificate/Masters/PhD in Health Professions Education (HPE)

- Application and acceptance to all HPE programs are required (with the exception of the “Getting Started in HPE” course).
- **2** Faculty Development Certificate Programs are offered
 - **Introduction to Foundations in HPE (I-FHPE)**
 - **6.5** credits required for completion, all available via DL
 - **Foundations in HPE (FHPE)**
 - **15** credits required for completion, all available via DL
- **3** Degrees are offered
 - **Master (MHPE), Master of Education (MEd -HPE), and PhD in HPE** Programs

1. USU Center for HPE

Master (MHPE) compared to Master of Education (MEd-HPE)

The coursework is essentially the same. However, the difference exists in the focus of the scholarly project completed in the second and third year.

- **MHPE:**

- Emphasis is on research competencies and design of educational research culminating in a peer-reviewed publication.

- **Med-HPE:**

- Emphasis is on education & leadership competencies, culminating in a project on education &/or leadership that will be disseminated by not published.

All of FHPE plus:

- Additional coursework
- Portfolio
- Culminating Project introduction and conclusion

FHPE

All of I-FHPE plus:

- Additional coursework totaling 15 credits

I-FHPE

Requirements:

- Coursework totaling 6.5 credits

MHPE

All of FHPE plus:

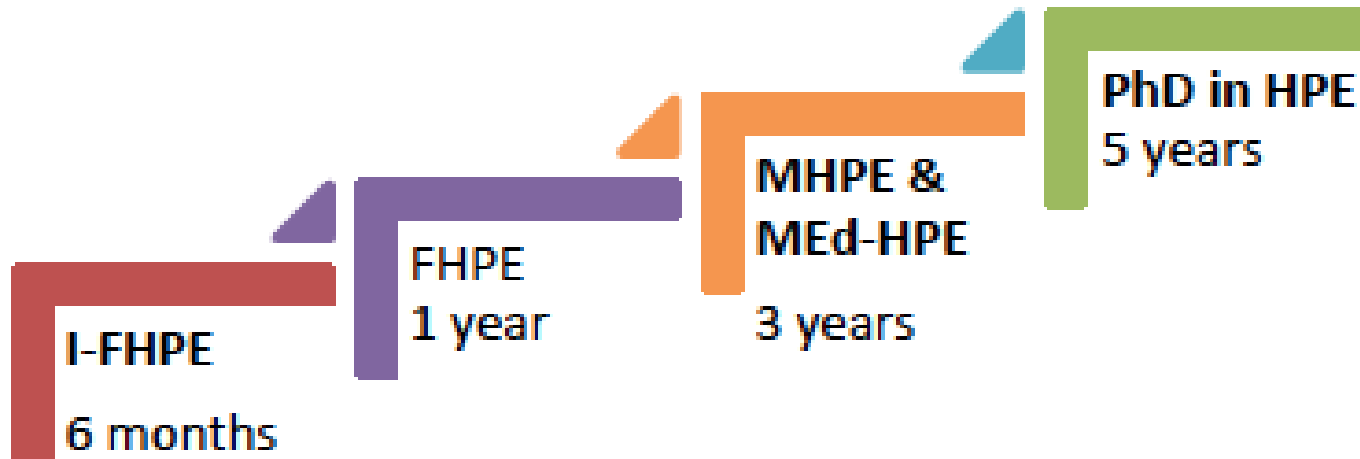
- Additional coursework
- Portfolio
- Practicum
- Thesis introduction & conclusion
- Paper accepted

All of MHPE plus:

- Additional coursework
- Additional practicum
- Expanded Portfolio
- Paper #2 accepted

2 Options

Stand-Alone Modules

1. Can enroll anytime, Self-paced, and you Don't need to apply to an HPE Certificate/Degree program.
2. Completion of each module earns a Certificate of Completion
3. Each module earns 2 credits toward any HPE Certificate or Degree Program if you subsequently apply to a program.
4. Certificates of Completion can apply to professional CE requirements and annotated on CV.

Integrated into HPE Certificate or Degree

1. Must apply to an HPE Certificate/Degree program.
2. Earns **2 credits for each** module completed (Max of **10 credits**) toward any HPE certificate/degree.
3. Can satisfy the credit hour requirement for the I-FHPE Certificate or be applied to higher level programs.
4. Application to graduate school is required to allow Graduate Transcript credit.

 - Attendance is focused toward new or emerging Program Directors
 - Completion meets the 30-credit hour requirement to earn the Faculty Development Certificate in Academic Leadership

Comparisons and Alignment of USU FD Programs

USU SOM FACDEV

- Primarily F2F Sessions
- 4 Certificates Offered
- Can be used for CE hours & CV

- Each completed Certificate earns 2 credits toward any CHPE program.
- **Credit Toward CHPE Program**

- No Graduate School Transcript

USU CHPE

- Primarily Distance Learning
- “Getting Started in HPE” with 6 Certificates offered (2 credits each)
- Can be used for CE hours & CV

Option for app to CHPE Program

- 2 Certs & 3 Degrees Offered
- Credit hours applied from:
 - “Getting Started in HPE”
 - USU SOM Certificate (2 credits)
- Can advance to higher degrees
- Graduate School Transcript

3. PDC-sponsored Faculty Development

PDC-sponsored “DFD I - Introduction to Graduate Teaching”
(available via distance learning on Sakai or Canvas)

- Consists of 7 modules over a 3-month period using a DL format on Sakai or Canvas.
- Earns **14 credit hours** toward the SOM FACDEV Certificate in Teaching.

3. PDC-sponsored Faculty Development

- PDC-sponsored attendance at American Dental Education Association, Academy for Academic Leadership, Institute for Teaching & Learning (ADEA AAL ITL)
 - Attendance is by **Invitation-Only** and advertised annually from each Service Dean.
 - Attendance is focused toward high-achieving junior dental educators, who are expected to assume increased level of responsibility in graduate dental education.

3. PDC-sponsored Faculty Development

- **Service-sponsored attendance at Federal Service Dental Educators' Workshop (FSDEW)**
 - Attendance is by **Invitation-Only** and advertised annually from each Service Dean.
 - Attendance is focused toward new or emerging Program Directors
 - Faculty Development Certificate credit hours are earned in various topic areas.

Putting a Strategy Together



1. Complete “Getting Started in HPE” course. Earns **up to 10 credits** toward all HPE certificate/degree programs.



Consider application for certificate/degree programs.
I-FHPE, FHPE, MHPE, Med or PhD in HPE.

2. Complete DFD-I course. Earns **14 credit hours** toward SOM FACDEV Certificate in Teaching



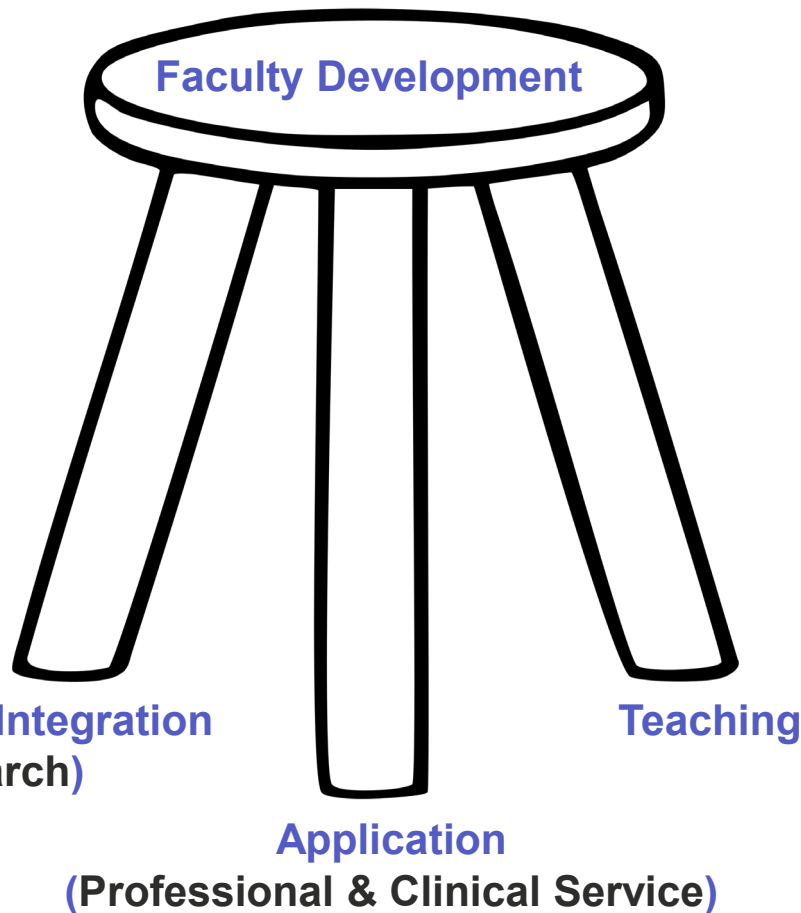
Consider future PDC-sponsored opportunities for FD.

3. Complete eligible FD courses for 16 credit hours...add to the 14 from DFD-I course to meet requirement for Certificate in Teaching.



Consider future SOM FD Certificates...Academic Leadership, Scholarship & Research, Advanced Teaching.

Why is this important?



- Clinical faculty typically begin their academic careers with minimal experience in most scholarship categories. Most of their skill sets are in the category of **Application (Professional and Clinical Service)**.
- Faculty Development is essential to build expertise in all scholarship areas, its a primary requirement for future academic promotion, and prepares faculty for additional career opportunities.
